- Limited availability in acute trauma setting
- long imaging times
- sensitivity to patient motion
- · incompatibility with various medical devices
- need for MR imaging-specific monitoring equipment and ventilator
- risk of scanning patients with certain indwelling devices (e.g. cardiac pacemaker, cerebral aneurysm clip) or foreign bodies.
